“Everyone Belongs” Community Campaign March 25–May 6



Hempfield Rec is on a mission to make sure that no one will be denied the opportunity to participate in our programs or services due to financial hardship. We need YOUR help to make this happen! Our second annual “Everyone Belongs” campaign will kick off March 25 with an ambitious goal to raise \$40,000—all of which is to come from community members and businesses. People just like you!

In fact, in 2014 more than 500 children and families benefitted from financial assistance. Behind each gift there is someone with a personal story whose life was changed. Requests for financial assistance have increased each year.

One such family was the Baldauffs of Landisville. John Baldauff, a single father with four young children, worked a construction job during the day and attended community college at night. Because he was able to apply for financial assistance, he enrolled two (and eventually all four)

of his children in our Day Camp program during the summers. John says, “I could never have afforded to put the kids in your camp on my own...and the support system kept me able to stay in my evening classes. Everyone went out of the way to be a tremendous help with my son (who has disabilities) and I didn’t have to worry about him.” John’s mother Judy, who was also a caregiver for the children, agrees, “Camp allowed my son John to know (the children) were supervised, active, and the staff was interested in the kids’ needs. It made all the difference for our family and we so appreciated the assistance. We are now giving back by donating to the campaign and volunteering at HARC special events.”

This year our campaign chairman, Steve Mummaw, with a team of more than 50 volunteers, will ask for pledges of financial support from people and businesses in our community. As a 501 (c)(3) organization, donations are tax-deductible and considered an investment in the lives of the children, adults, families and senior citizens who need support the most. Your gift, no matter how large or small, will ensure that everyone can participate in programs even if they are facing financial hardships.


