Safety Committee Sets Storm Shelter Area

The Safety Committee of Hempfield Rec has designated the hallway by its gymnasium as a safe location in the event of a threat of a tornado or dangerous storms. This location is ideal in that it is away from windows and on the bottom floor of the main structure. When and if a tornado or dangerous

storms are predicted, HARC staff will direct all persons in the facility to this location until the threat is lifted.

The Safety Committee is comprised of management and part time employees who meet monthly to monitor the safety of its members and staff. The committee reviews safety procedures and advocates safe practices throughout the organization.
